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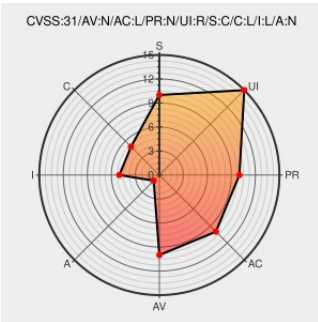

Certain versions of **Pmb** from **Pmb Project** contain the following vulnerability:

PMB v7.4.6 was discovered to contain an open redirect vulnerability via the component `/opac_css/pmb.php`. This vulnerability allows attackers to redirect victim users to an external domain via a crafted URL.

CVE-2023-24735 has been assigned by [M cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
