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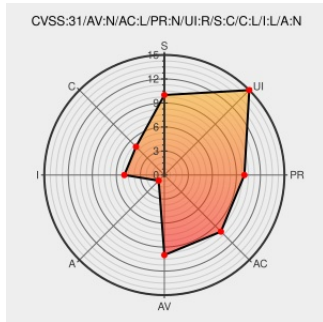

PMB v7.4.6 was discovered to contain a reflected cross-site scripting (XSS) vulnerability via the query parameter at `/admin/convert/export_z3950.php`.
