

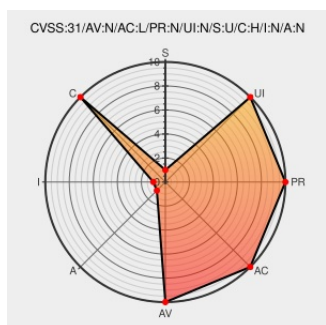

Certain versions of [Swig-templates](#) from [Swig-templates Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Directory traversal vulnerability in swig-templates thru 2.0.4 and swig thru 1.4.2, allows attackers to read arbitrary files via the include or extends tags.

CVE-2023-25345 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
