

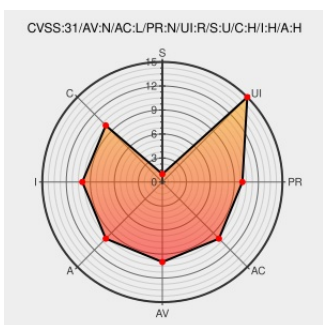

Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in Anton Skorobogatov Rus-To-Lat plugin <= 0.3 versions.
