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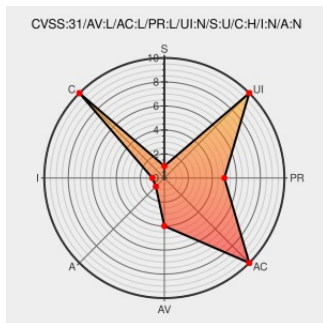

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Certain versions of **Fortiguest** from **Fortinet** contain the following vulnerability:

An insertion of sensitive information into log file vulnerability in Fortinet FortiGuest 1.0.0 allows a local attacker to access plaintext passwords in the RADIUS logs.

CVE-2023-25604 has been assigned by psirt@fortinet.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
