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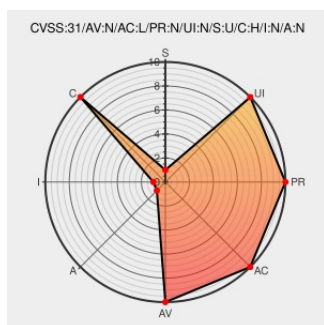

Certain versions of **ldweb** from **ldattend** contain the following vulnerability:

Missing authentication in the SearchStudentsRFID method in IDAttend's IDWeb application 3.1.052 and earlier allows extraction sensitive student data by unauthenticated attackers.

CVE-2023-26576 has been assigned by vdp@themissinglink.com.au to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
