

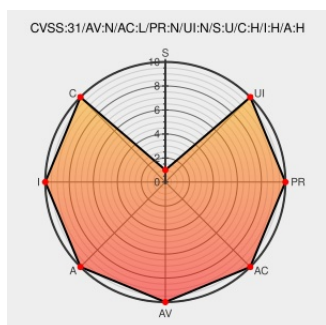

Certain versions of [Who](#) from [Whoapp](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue found in WHOv.1.0.28, v.1.0.30, v.1.0.32 allows an attacker to cause a escalation of privileges via the TTMultiProvider component.

CVE-2023-27654 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
