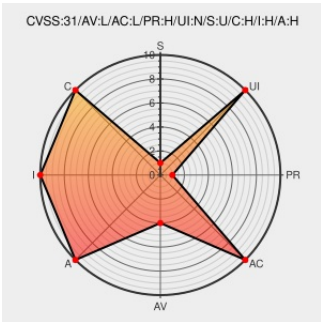

Certain versions of [Proset/wireless Wifi](#) from [Intel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Improper access control in firmware for some Intel(R) PROSet/Wireless WiFi software for Windows before version 22.220 HF (Hot Fix) may allow a privileged user to potentially enable escalation of privilege via local access.

CVE-2023-28714 has been assigned by [intel secure@intel.com](mailto:secure@intel.com) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
