

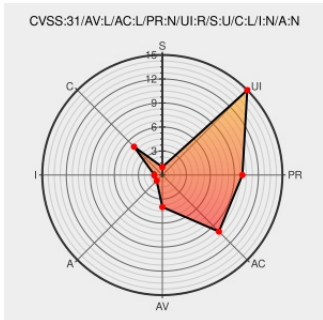

Certain versions of [Macos](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A privacy issue was addressed with improved handling of temporary files. This issue is fixed in macOS Sonoma 14. An app may be able to access calendar data saved to a temporary directory.

CVE-2023-29497 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **LOW** severity.
