

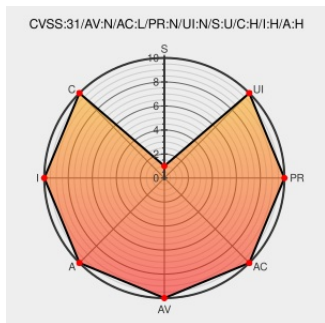

Certain versions of [Solive](#) from [Loka](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SoLive 1.6.14 thru 1.6.20 for Android exists exposed component, the component provides the method to modify the SharedPreferences file. The attacker can use the method to modify the data in any SharedPreferences file, these data will be loaded into the memory when the application is opened. Depending on how the data is used, this can result in various attack consequences, such as ad display exceptions.

CVE-2023-29732 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
