

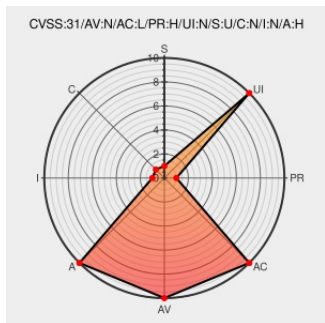

Certain versions of [Magic R200 Firmware](#) from [H3c](#) contain the following vulnerability:

H3C Magic R200 version R200V100R004 was discovered to contain a stack overflow via the UpdateSnat interface at /goform/aspForm.

CVE-2023-29905 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
