Certain versions of [Virtuoso](#) from [Openlinksw](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue in the `sinv_check_exp` component of `openlink virtuoso-opensource v7.2.9` allows attackers to cause a Denial of Service (DoS) via crafted SQL statements.

CVE-2023-31624 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
