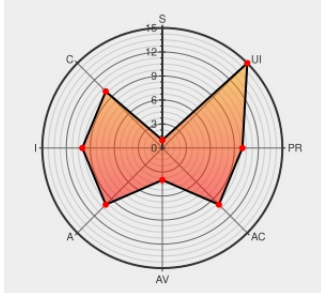

Certain versions of [Gin](#) from [Gin Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Gin 0.7.4 allows execution of arbitrary code when a crafted file is opened, e.g., via `require('child_process')`.

CVE-2023-31873 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
