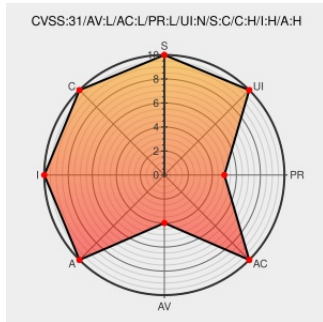

EaseUS Todo Backup version 20220111.390 - An omission during installation may allow a local attacker to perform privilege escalation.
