

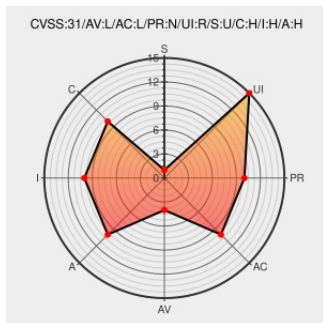

Certain versions of **Ipad Os** from **Apple** contain the following vulnerability:

The issue was addressed with improved memory handling. This issue is fixed in iOS 16.5 and iPadOS 16.5, watchOS 9.5. An app may be able to gain elevated privileges.

CVE-2023-32425 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
