

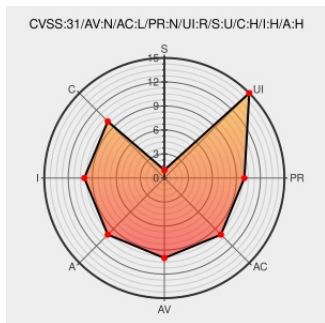

In Sogou Workflow v0.10.6, memcpy a negative size in URIParser::parse , may cause buffer-overflow and crash.
