

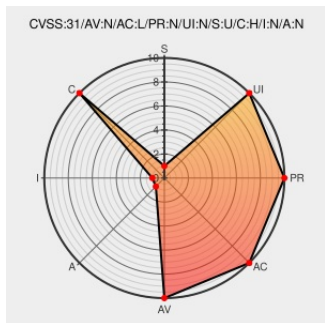

Incorrect access control in luowice v3.5.18 allows attackers to access cloud source code information via modification to the Verify parameter in a warning message.
