Certain versions of [Jsonij](#) from [Jsonij Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered jmarsden/jsonij thru 0.5.2 allows attackers to cause a denial of service or other unspecified impacts via crafted object that uses cyclic dependencies.

CVE-2023-34614 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
