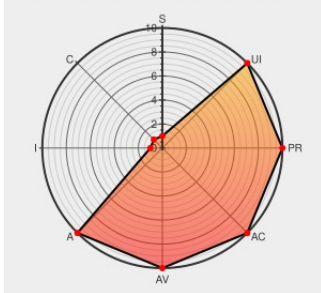

Certain versions of [Pbjson](#) from [Pbjson Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered pbjson thru 0.4.0 allows attackers to cause a denial of service or other unspecified impacts via crafted object that uses cyclic dependencies.

CVE-2023-34616 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
