

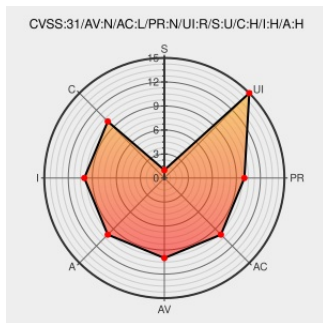

Certain versions of [Wp Social Autoconnect](#) from [Wp Social Autoconnect Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in Justin Klein WP Social AutoConnect plugin <= 4.6.1 versions.

CVE-2023-37974 has been assigned by audit@patchstack.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Justin Klein - WP Social AutoConnect** version **not down converted**
