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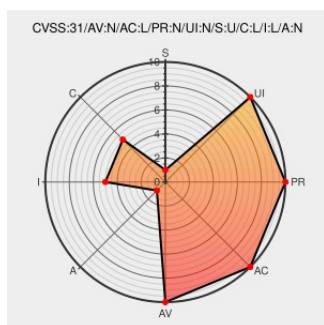
CVE-2023-39045

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Certain versions of [Kokoroe Members Card](#) from [Kokoroe Members Card Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An information leak in kokoroe_members card Line 13.6.1 allows attackers to obtain the channel access token and send crafted messages.

CVE-2023-39045 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
