

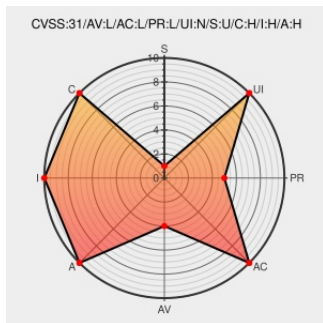

Certain versions of [Fortitester](#) from [Fortinet](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A use of hard-coded credentials vulnerability [CWE-798] in FortiTester 2.3.0 through 7.2.3 may allow an attacker who managed to get a shell on the device to access the database via shell commands.

CVE-2023-40717 has been assigned by [psirt@fortinet.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
