

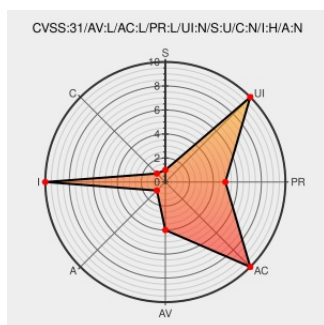

Certain versions of [Macos](#) from [Apple](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A logic issue was addressed with improved checks. This issue is fixed in macOS Sonoma 14. An app may bypass Gatekeeper checks.

CVE-2023-41067 has been assigned by product-security@apple.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.

Affected Vendor/Software: **Apple** - **macOS** version < 14
