The vulnerability allows an attacker to execute arbitrary SQL code by injecting a payload into the login.php file. The vulnerability is located in the login.php file, which is responsible for authenticating users. The vulnerability is classified as critical because it allows an attacker to gain unauthorized access to the system and potentially steal sensitive data.
