Certain versions of [EventPrime](#) from [Unknown](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The EventPrime WordPress plugin before 3.2.0 does not have CSRF checks when creating bookings, which could allow attackers to make logged in users create unwanted bookings via CSRF attacks.
