Certain versions of [Free Hospital Management System For Small Practices](#) from [Free Hospital Management System For Small Practices Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A vulnerability was found in SourceCodester Free Hospital Management System for Small Practices 1.0. It has been declared as critical. This vulnerability affects unknown code of the file

/patient/appointment.php. The manipulation of the argument sheduledate leads to sql injection. The attack can be initiated remotely. VDB-237562 is the identifier assigned to this vulnerability.

CVE-2023-4441 has been assigned by cna@vuldb.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
