Certain versions of [Contact Form By Formget](#) from [Formget](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Contact Form by FormGet plugin for WordPress is vulnerable to Stored Cross-Site Scripting via 'formget' shortcode in versions up to, and including, 5.5.5 due to insufficient input sanitization and output escaping on user supplied attributes. This makes it possible for authenticated attackers with contributor-level and above permissions to

inject arbitrary web scripts in pages that will execute whenever a user accesses an injected page.

CVE-2023-5125 has been assigned by security@wordfence.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
