Certain versions of [Mattermost Server](#) from [Mattermost](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Mattermost fails to enforce a limit for the size of the cache entry for OpenGraph data allowing an attacker to send a specially crafted request to the `/api/v4/opengraph` filling the cache and turning the server unavailable.

CVE-2023-5330 has been assigned by [responsible@mattermost.com](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
