<b>Description</b>	The Sertifier Certificate & Badge Maker for WordPress – Tutor LMS plugin for WordPress is vulnerable to Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) via an unauthenticated request to the /wp-admin/options-general.php?page=tutor-lms-sertifier-certificate&update=settings option. An attacker can hijack the user's session and change the site's settings. This vulnerability affects versions of the plugin prior to 1.19.
